KANSAS CITY, MO, FEBRUARY 12, 2016: The *Art of Blues & Jazz, KC Style* will open on First Friday, March 4, 2016, from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m., at Buttonwood Art Space, 3013 Main, Kansas City, Missouri, 64108. The gallery exhibition includes 95 artworks by 27 artists and expresses the influence of music, especially Blues and Jazz, through painting, photography, mixed media, fiber and sculpture. The exhibit will be held in conjunction with KC Crossroads March First Friday Art Walk.

Purchases of art during the exhibit will benefit two local music organizations: Kansas City Blues Society and KC Jazz ALIVE. Half of the sale price compensates artists for their beautiful art with the remainder going to the music organizations as charitable donations.

Meet participating artists, enjoy Food Truck flavors from Chris Miller Foods, listen to musical performances by Karla Bauer and by duo Karla Peterie and Jim Herbert and enjoy a beverage at the March 4th Opening Reception. "Everything Must Change" is a soulful Jazz tribute to the great Nina Simone encapsulating the striking vocal

power and beauty of the Kansas City-based singer. "Everything Must Change" tells a story opening with a direct message to the listener. The final track plays out as if someone yanked the curtains up in a dark room. It's truly staggering how taking this project as a whole, the "vintage-made-new" songs address the same desires of peace and hope today that Nina Simone sang of so many years ago. The nostalgic mood of this CD is the perfect fit for Karla as an artist who reached back decades for her inspiration. Karla assembled the collection of songs once recorded by Nina Simone to radiate a message that to change the

Playing songs that have weathered the generations, Karla & Jim perform music ranging in style from old time jug band blues & boogie woogie up thru the driving rhythms of early rock & roll. Karla & Jim were recent semi-finalists in the 2016 International Blues Challenge in Memphis competing against over 90 Solo/Duo entries from around



the world. They will be performing songs from their self-titled CD, "Karla and Too Bad Jim".
